I am requesting funding for 26 Mile Road and Hayes Road - Intersection for fiscal year 2025. The project recipient is Macomb Township located at 54111 Broughton Road, Macomb, MI 48042.

This project funds improvements at the intersection of 26 Mile Road and Hayes Road. This intersection is unique in that it is at a corner where four communities meet: Macomb Township, Ray Township, Washington Township, Shelby Township. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses safety concerns, traffic congestion, and quality of life for the residents around this area. The current intersection layout poses a safety hazard for motorists and pedestrians due to congestion, inadequate signage, or poor visibility.
